BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS – Hear requests from property owners for variance to the Zoning Code. Alternate and regular positions open. Meet 4th Thursday of a month *if there is a case*.

CABLE T.V. COMMITTEE – Oversee local cable television operation. Meet as needed and by arrangement with Board Members.

DISABILITY RIGHTS COMMITTEE – Hear complaints filed by those believing disability rights have been compromised. Meet as needed.

ETHICS COMMITTEE – Meet to hear and made recommendation regarding local government ethics complaints. Meet as needed.

LANDMARKS COMMISSION. Committee designates Landmarks in the City and provides public information regarding historical sites. Meet monthly.

LIBRARY BOARD. Oversees management of Irvin L. Young Memorial Library. Meet monthly. (alternate member position open).

PLAN AND ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMISSION. (Alternate position). Reviews plans for development within the City and makes recommendation to Common Council regarding certain ordinances. Meet monthly.

PUBLIC ARTS COMMISSION. Newly created Committee to oversee public art displays on public property.
