Subject: Capital Improvement Program & Truck Routes

Capital Improvement Plan

Staff is recommending that the CIP project schedule be revised. Attached you will find the Council approved schedule and the Proposed New Schedule.

There are four main reasons for the request of schedule change:

- Milwaukee Street did not survive this winter very well. DPW is putting a lot labor and material into the daily maintenance of the street. Staff feels that Milwaukee Street is a higher priority for reconstruction than Clay Street.
- Staff applied for Surface Transportation Program (STP) monies for the engineering and the reconstruction of the Milwaukee Street (Esterly to Wisconsin). Whitewater's project did not make the funding list. The next time we could apply would be 2012 and if the City was successful, the funding would not be available until 2015& 2016. We can apply for STP funding for Clay Street.
- The Milwaukee/Newcomb intersection is scheduled for 2014. As part of this project the sanitary sewer is planned to be lowered to alleviate a backup problem on Newcomb and East Main Street. In order to lower this section of sewer the sewer on Milwaukee from Wisconsin to Esterly needs to be lowered and completed before the intersection work. This sewer work needs to be completed before the intersection work begins.
- The approved CIP planned to do the Downtown Eastgate, Milwaukee (Esterly to Wisconsin), and the Newcomb/Milwaukee intersection in the same year. As staff kept looking at that plan, we determined it would be extremely difficult to reconstruct that much in one year alone trying to coordinate with possibly three different contractors. Additionally the disruption not only for the Milwaukee Street businesses, but anyone traveling on the eastside would be tremendous.

Also included with this memo are colored maps indicating the projects as the staff sees them being constructed by each year. The mapping also shows the routes available for detouring or getting around the construction. Attached is a sheet titled CIP – Eastside projects. This sheet has some of the staffs thoughts and ideas that need to be considered for these projects including helping with business signage. It is pretty important that some decisions be made about the CIP as staff is preparing for the borrowing for the projects for general fund, water, and sewer.

On the Council tour Wednesday staff will review some the streets to start the discussion for the CIP later on.

Truck Routes

Staff wants to have a discussion about the possibility of limiting truck traffic on some streets. The reason for the discussion is to preserve the integrity of City's streets, plus the decision plays a big part in the design of the intersection of Newcomb/Milwaukee and the Downtown Eastgate intersection of Wisconsin/East Main.


