NOTICE TO ELECTORS: THIS BALLOT MAY BE INVALID UNLESS INITIALED BY 2 ELECTION INSPECTORS. IF CAST AS AN ABSENTEE BALLOT, THE BALLOT MUST BEAR THE INITIALS OF THE MUNICIPAL CLERK OR DEPUTY CLERK.

IMPORTANT: USE A #2 PENCIL OR THE MARKING PEN PROVIDED. DO NOT USE RED INK!

To vote for the candidate of your choice, complete the arrow \leftarrow to the RIGHT of the candidate's name. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, write the person's name on the line provided and complete the arrow \leftarrow to the RIGHT of the line. To vote on a question, complete the arrow \leftarrow to the RIGHT of "YES" if in favor of the question, or complete the arrow \leftarrow to the RIGHT of "NO" if opposed to the question.
