V. Adjournment - On a motion by Knopp with a second by Haberman the Commissioners unanimously voted to adjourn.

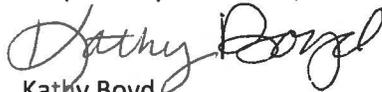
