BACKGROUND

A request was received from the residents of 210 Green Street along with nearby residents for the installation of a street light near 210 Green Street. Other residents signing the request live at 239 E. Milwaukee Street, 305 E. Milwaukee Street, 555 Clay Street, 121 Green Street and 224 Green Street.

Currently there are two street lights on Green Street. The distance between the nearest street light on Milwaukee Street to the northernmost street light on Green Street is about 354 feet. The distance between the two street lights on Green Street is around 226 feet. The distance from the southernmost street light on Green Street to the nearest street light on Clay Street is around 215 feet.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Based on past WE Energies costs, the fixture install cost is \$150 with an ongoing monthly charge of \$12.73.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The installation of a street light at 210 Green Street would split the distance between the Milwaukee Street street light and the existing northernmost street light on Green Street. The resulting distance of about 177 feet between the lights is a bit on the short side, but the existing distance of about 354 feet is on the longer side. Staff would recommend the installation of a street light at the proposed location at 210 Green Street if it is acceptable to WE Energies. If the light cannot be installed at this location due to the transformer on the pole, staff does not recommend an installation at a different location.
