Dear Property Owner or Resident:

You are invited to attend a Public Involvement meeting to discuss the proposed reconstruction of Clay Street, from Dann Street to Rice Street, located in Walworth County, Whitewater, Wisconsin, as shown below.



The meeting will take place at the **Cravath Lakefront Community Center, 341 S Fremont Street, from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m. on March 13, 2019**. Parking will be available in Parking Lot B adjacent to the Cravath Lakefront Community Center. The meeting is an “Open House” format to allow for dialogue, individual questions, and comments. The City of Whitewater and consultant representatives will give a brief presentation at 5:15 p.m. and will be available to discuss the proposed project and address any questions or concerns before and after the presentation.

Approximately 0.6 miles of Clay Street will be reconstructed, from Dann Street to Rice Street. The reconstructed street will be an urban section with new curb and gutter, sidewalk on the south side, and asphalt pavement. In addition to the proposed surface improvements, sanitary sewer, water main, and storm sewer will be improved as part the project. The purpose of the meeting is to provide an update on the status of the design and solicit input from the public or other project stakeholders.

Note: The project will require some temporary limited easements (TLEs) from a limited number of landowners. Where road reconstruction activities require construction outside of the existing right of way (ROW), owners will be contacted with a separate project letter. Two evening meeting times will be made available for such owners. Easement needs for specific parcels can be discussed on parcel-specific basis at that time.

The design work on the project is scheduled for completion by August of 2019. Construction is currently scheduled for 2020 and is dependent on WisDOT's funding availability.

The meeting location is wheelchair accessible. Citizens who are deaf, hard of hearing, blind or speech impaired are encouraged to use the Wisconsin Telecommunication Relay System by dialing 711.
