- POLICE DEPARTMENT MUST BE CALLED BEFORE YOU START THE FIRE.
(PH #262-473-0555 EXT #4)
- ALL BURNING MUST TAKE PLACE ONLY BETWEEN 1/2 HOUR AFTER SUNRISE AND 1/2 HOUR BEFORE SUNSET (FIRE MUST BE TOTALLY EXTINGUISHED).
- THE PROPERTY OWNER WILL BE BILLED IF FIRE DEPARTMENT IS CALLED OUT.
(Minimum of \$900.00)
- Per the City of Whitewater Municipal Code only natural material shall be burned within the city limits. Only wood, brush or coal may be burnt (8.32.010). Any violation of the burn permit may inquire a fine not less than \$25.00 and no more than \$250.00 for a first offence and no less than \$50.00 and no more than \$250.00 for any subsequent offences (8.32.020).
- All neighboring properties within 200 feet of the burn site MUST be notified of the burn taking place at said location.
- All outdoor fires shall be no closer than fifteen feet from any structure or side lot line and ten feet from any rear lot line. There shall be no outdoor fires in front yards or street yards (8.32.010.b.1).
