Why Illegal?

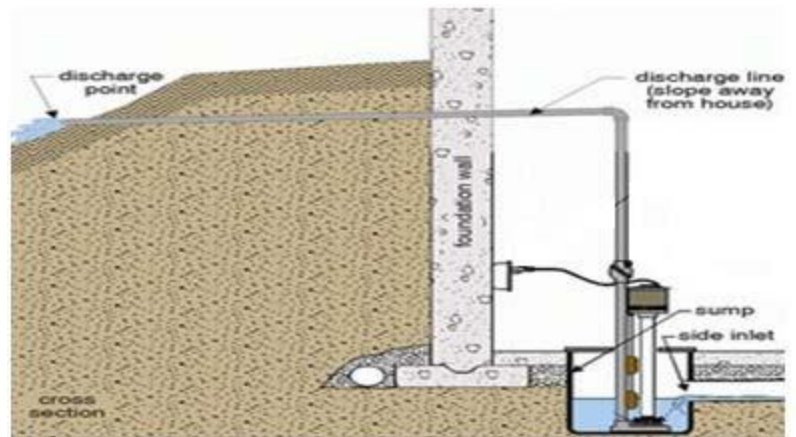
- Overloads Private Sanitary Lines

City Ordinance (16.14.570)

No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any stormwater, foundation drainwater, groundwater, roof runoff, surface drainage, or unpolluted industrial cooling waters to any sewer connected to the city's waste treatment plant. (Ord. 959 (part), 1980).
